THOMPSON SQUARE CONTINUOUSLY OCCUPIED FOR SIX MONTHS

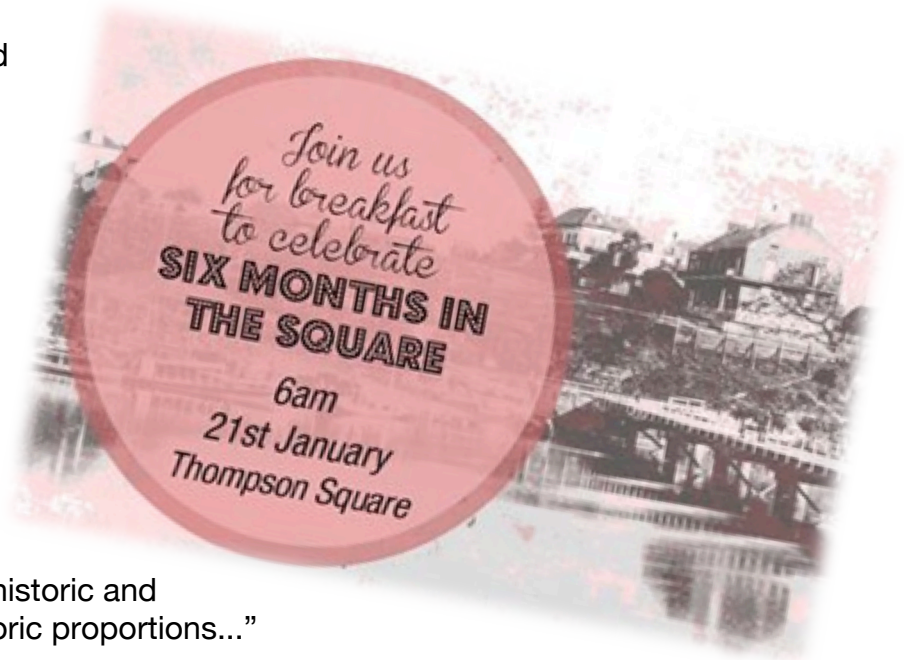

Thompson Square has been continuously occupied by community members for six months, since Sunday, 21st July 2013.

Despite planning approval being granted by Minister Hazzard just five days before Christmas, the 'CAWB Consulate' in the Square remains occupied 24 hours a day, seven days a week and is proving to be a powerful symbol of resistance and a rallying point for the mounting community anger towards the State Government over this matter.

The Minister's decision effectively means Windsor is being denied basic infrastructure. Whilst Windsor is a heritage town, when it comes to traffic management, the community has a right to a twenty first century solution - a bypass... not the sort of solution that was acceptable in the 19th century.
